**FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION - PARTS MANUFACTURER APPROVAL**

In accordance with Title 14, Code of Federal Regulations (14 CFR), part 21, Certification Procedures for Products and Parts, subpart K, the FAA has found that the design data, as submitted by Aerospace Turbine Rotables, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as "the Manufacturer") on December 1, 2009, meet the airworthiness requirements of 14 CFR applicable to the product(s) on which the part(s) is to be installed. Additionally, the FAA has determined that the Manufacturer has established the Fabrication Inspection System (FIS) required by § 21.303(h) at 3414 West 29<sup>th</sup> Street South, Wichita, Kansas 67217. Accordingly, Parts Manufacturer Approval (PMA) is hereby granted to the Manufacturer to produce the replacement parts (or modification parts, as applicable) listed in the enclosed supplement(s) in conformity with the FAA-approved design data. Subsequent changes to these design data must be approved in a manner acceptable to the FAA.

The following terms and conditions apply to this approval:

1. The Manufacturer's FIS, methods, procedures, and manufacturing facilities, including suppliers, are subject to FAA surveillance and investigations. Accordingly, the Manufacturer must advise its suppliers that their facilities are also subject to FAA surveillance and investigations.
2. The Manufacturer must notify the Wichita Manufacturing Inspection District Office (MIDO) in writing within ten working days from the date the manufacturing facilities, at which parts are manufactured, are relocated or expanded, to include additional facilities at other locations. This requirement also applies to the Manufacturer's suppliers with major inspection authorization, and those suppliers who furnish parts or related services where a determination of safety and conformance to the approved design cannot or will not be made upon receipt at the approved receiving facility.
